
Topic	Ecological terms	Level	GCSE (or any course for students aged 11-16)
Outcomes	To understand the meanings of the following terms: habitat, species, population, community, abiotic, ecosystem, interdependence and competition.		
Information for teachers	This activity is based on the Frayer model to teach vocabulary. You could use this activity at the beginning of any unit on ecology, either to introduce these words or to activate prior knowledge. It can be quite useful to ask students to write down what they think the word means first, before providing them with the definition. Avoid asking students to come up with their own definition. You could ask specific students to read out their sentences to check understanding before they complete the final task on slide 12.

Examples


pond, forest, grassland, rainforest




